

## **AUDIT**

You may audit the actions on a table by the Audit function.

eg.

```
SQL> AUDIT DELETE ON table_name BY ACCESS
```

Which says for each access on a table 'table\_name' record information about deletions.

To turn this off we say:

```
NOAUDIT DELETE ON table_name;
```

Or you can audit general actions by a specific user

eg

```
AUDIT SELECT TABLE BY SCOTT BY ACCESS;
```

To turn it off, we say:

```
NOAUDIT SELECT TABLE BY SCOTT
```

To clean AUDIT information from the database, we truncate the view:

```
TRUNCATE TABLE SYS.AUD$;
```
